## Tools to get started

### -Basic cutting kit

\*Hair cutting scissors



\*Fine comb



\*Clippers



\*Length Guards



\*Oil



- cup of water, or spray bottle of water
- plastic hair protection cape. We use a plastic shower curtain, a cheap rain poncho, or even a towel works fine if you are willing to take the time to get the hair out.
- a wide enough linoleum or tile space for easy clean up and cutting, and an outlet. You can also use a carpeted space, but prepare to fill your vacuum quickly.
- An apron to protect YOU from the hair.
